All times of services throughout the High Holydays and Sukkot are printed on a special Timetable, which will be available in the Shul foyer, as well as being posted on the notice board.

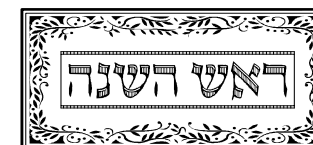
