CHALLAH: Focusing on the Future *Thoughts on the Parasha.*

Back in the 'Heim' in the years prior to World War II, it was well known that two of the Eastern European Chassidic groups of Belz and Munkatch did not always see eye to eye. And in the town of Munkatch, a Belzer chassid named Moshe Silber lived there. Fiercely loyal to the Belzer Rebbe, Moshe would often have arguments with the Munkatcher Rebbe. One day, in the midst of a heated argument, the Munkatcher Rebbe turned to Moshe Silber and said, "You will die with your Tallis katan on!".

Some years later, World War II came and Moshe Silber was deported to Auschwitz. The threat of death was constant: He suffered hunger, illness and cruel brutality. Of course, in Auschwitz there was no way of wearing a Tallis. But Moshe never doubted that he would survive Auschwitz. Because after all, the great Tzaddik, the Munkatcher Rebbe, told him that he would die with his Tallis on and indeed, he survived the war. After immigrating to America, he would sit wearing his Tallis telling his visitors wonderful stories about his former opponent, the Munkatcher Rebbe - whose words had given him the strength and hope to survive the Holocaust.

Focusing on the future often get people through challenging times of crisis and tragedy. Such an instance is alluded to in our Parasha.

Moshe Rabbenu, at the request of the Jewish people, sends a group of spies to spy on the land of Israel. Ten of the 12 spies bring back a negative report and warn of the great danger if they enter the land. The Canaanites, they explain, are very strong and the Jews will be no match for them. And even when Calev and Yehoshua, argue against those conclusion, the people do not believe them and they begin to despair. Many speak openly of abandoning the journey and returning to Egypt. Upset at their lack of faith, Hashem informs them that they will wander 40 years in the desert, and only their children will inherit the land.

The Midrash points out that this was for the good as it became clear that the people needed more time in the desert to grow spiritually, and to gain a greater confidence in Hashem.

And in an effort to reassure them that they will eventually reach the land of Israel Hashem instructs Moshe to teach the Jewish People the mitzvah of "Challah." (to separate a portion of the dough and to give it to the Kohanim.) This Mitzvah could initially only be observed after the People entered the land of Israel. It was a great comfort for the people that though their current circumstances were challenging, they had a wonderful future to look forward to.
