Board of Deputies Delegates

As members will know, Mr Peter Baum and Mr Eric Harris were appointed by the last Council as the SWHC delegates at the Board of Deputies. The Board has recently informed us that in accordance with the Board of Deputies constitution and our own SWHC Articles of Association our delegates should have been elected at the last AGM. Technically a Board appointment was not sufficient.

Accordingly, to correct this technical defect we have agreed to seek approval from our members for the appointment of Peter Baum and Eric Harris.

We hereby invite Peter Baum and Eric Harris to confirm that they will stand as SWHC's two Board of Deputies delegates. To be within the rules we must, and also now invite, any other SWHC member who wishes to stand for election as a Board of Deputies delegate to put their name forward for election by the 3rd August 2018. Most Board of Deputies meetings take place in London on Sundays, so anyone interested in putting themselves forward for election as a delegate must confirm that they will make themselves available to attend these meetings.

If Peter Baum and Eric Harris are our only candidates for election, then their appointment will stand. At the next SWHC AGM we will seek ratification of their appointment. If they are not the only candidates a general meeting will be called as soon as possible at which time an election will take place.

Finally, we thank Peter and Eric for the valuable work that they have been doing as our delegates in this interim period and apologise to them for the inconvenience caused by this technical error.
