THE STORY OF THE WELLS *Thoughts on the Parasha*

What is the meaning of Yitzchak's three wells?

Water in the wells symbolizes the spiritual wealth that is hidden beneath the layers of worldly materialism. Avraham the founder of monotheism, spiritual father to all of mankind was showing the world how much they could accomplish in their spiritual quests. He did so by digging wells, which represent our constant search for spiritual riches that lay buried beneath the surface. The Philistines rejected his teachings, but Yitzchak carried it on and passed it to future generations.

Maase Avot Siman Labanim is the well-known principal that the life stories of our Patriarchs as mentioned in the Torah carry an important and relevant lesson for us, their children. The three wells correspond to the three of our Temples – *Batei Hamikdash*, the two that were destroyed, and the eternal one yet to be built. They are represented by the wells of water *Mayim Chaim* – living water – just as the *Batei Mikdash* brought and will bring spiritual life to humanity.

The first well, was named *Esek* – contention – refers to the First *Bet Hamikdash*, which fell victim to the Babylonians led by Nevuchadnetzar who ultimately destroyed it. The second well, *Sitnah* - hatefulness - a harsher name than *Esek*, alludes to the Second *Bet Hamikdash* period, when Israel's enemies, the Greeks led by Caesar, fought us with greater and long lasting hate culminating with the destruction of the *Beit Hamikdash*.

The third well, *Rehovot* – spaciousness – alludes to the future and Third *Bet Hamikdash*, it will herald the times of Mashiach when contention and hate will be things of the past.

Just like Yitzchak, after fighting over the second well, moved away, and after some time he dug a third well where he enjoyed peace and tranquillity. In a similar fashion, ever since the destruction of the Second Temple we have been in exiled from our Land of Israel and a long period has elapsed, we are eagerly waiting for the Third Temple, may it come speedily in our days, Amen!
