THOUGHTS ON THIS WEEK'S PARSHA *from Jeremy Symons*

The craziest thing about the Korach story is that Korach's original reason for his protest against Aaron as the Kohen Gadol wasn't so crazy at all. Korach asks "As all of Hashem's nation is deemed holy, why did you raise yourself above us?" Meaning that everyone is equal and that everyone has the potential, no matter who they are or what their background is, to achieve great spiritual heights

According to Rashi, Korach's mistake was that Korach created a separation between himself and the rest of B'nai Yisrael in making this accusation. I believe maybe Korach's original intentions were just for fairness and equality for all of B'nai Yisrael, in terms of their potential and their ability to lead. But Korach should have approached his argument differently. If he had only viewed his concerns with Moshe and Aaron in private, instead of publicly in front of everyone, then maybe things might have turned out differently. The fact Korach aired his opinions openly, only vilified him and rightfully so.

One of Korach's points of contention was that Moshe was fabricating the Torah laws under the guise of Hashem's name. Korach and his followers asked Moshe the following questions: Is a garment made entirely of Techelet (special blue dye) still obligated in Tzitzits? And does a house filled with Torah scrolls require a Mezuzah on its door post? When Moshe replied with the correct answer that a garment made entirely of Techelet is indeed obligated in Tzitzits, and that a house full of Torah scroll does need a Mezuzah, Korach and 250 heads of the nation mocked him, claiming that this was completely illogical.

On one level I can appreciate Korach's argument and concerns because at that precise moment in time, after witnessing the giving of the Torah at mount Sinai, all of B'nai Yisrael were on the same level of prophecy as each other. However, being equally holy and close to Hashem does not give us the right to understand his deepest secrets. Korach's attitude was that if something was beyond his understanding then it must be that Moshe had fabricated it and bent the truth.

This arrogance was Korach's major error that ultimately led to his downfall. Many times we assume that we must have complete understanding of a person or any given situation. We cannot even imagine that our knowledge may be limited, that there is some piece of information of which we are not privy to. When we think with this arrogant attitude like that of Korach, we can end up making very big mistakes.

May we all strive to be able to accept our own limitations and achieve a humble approach to all situations in life.
