## SEDRA SUMMARY *from Rabbi Geoffrey Hyman*

The Great Flood occupies a large part of this week's Sedra.

After the Flood the world begins anew with Noah and his family, together with the species of animals that were preserved in the Ark.

The Rainbow is to be a reminder of G-d's promise not to destroy "all flesh" by a flood again; hence, a special bracha is recited on seeing a rainbow.

Noah plants a vineyard and becomes "drunk and disorderly," which brings shame on him; this was witnessed by his three sons.

The Sedra then maps out the descendants of the three sons and the development of the 70 nations.

In Chapter 11 the story of the Tower of Babel and the subsequent dispersion is detailed. Once again the human race had degenerated into wickedness. But the birth of Abram, mentioned in the closing part of the Sedra, paves the way for a better world in the future.
